PS Energy, Clean Energy & Clean Cities Atlanta to Host Government & Business Leaders at Opening of New Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Stations

Public Access CNG Will Support Metro Atlanta Deployment of Clean, Green Fleets of Municipal and Commercial CNG Trucks, Vans & Shuttles

WHAT: **Grand Opening Ceremonies** at this new CNG fueling station located at the PSE Energy UFO in Lithonia, Georgia and operated by Clean Energy. This project is partially funded through the [Clean Cities Atlanta Petroleum Reduction Program](#) awarded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 by the US Department of Energy. The second of four planned CNG fueling facilities is now open at the East Point UFO.

The Lithonia and East Point stations are part of a Metro Atlanta network of CNG fueling facilities to be operated by Clean Energy at existing PS Energy UFO sites.

SIGNIFICANCE: CNG vehicles run *cleaner* than diesel or gasoline-powered models (30% lower greenhouse gas emissions in light-duty vehicles and 23% lower emissions in medium-to-heavy-duty vehicles).

CNG is *cheaper* than gasoline or diesel, costing up to \$1.50 less per gallon equivalent.

CNG is *sourced domestically*, which helps reduce America’s dependence on foreign oil.
